As a unique meeting point between business academia and the public sector, the RLL promote experimentation and discussion on new innovative solutions

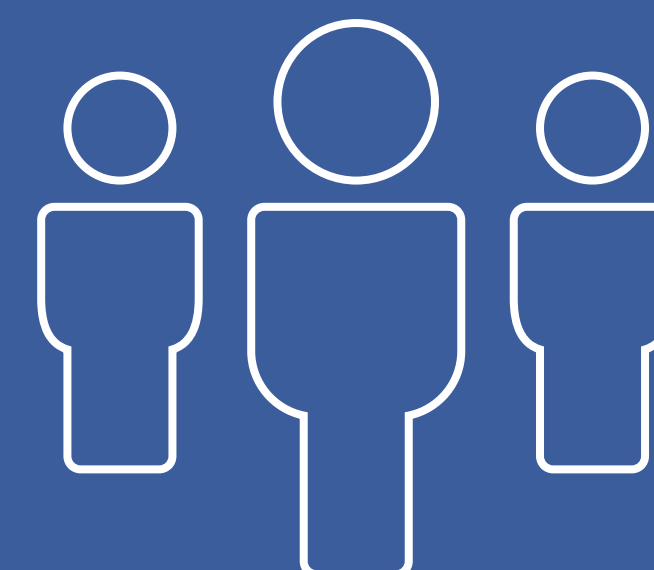

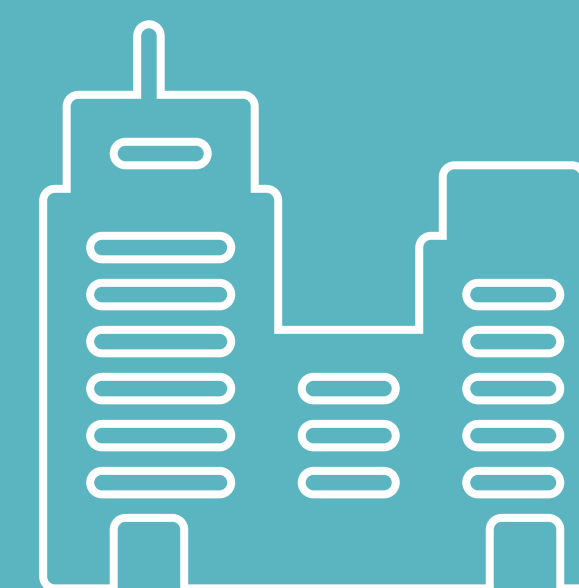
